- ✚ A public section and secure section
- ✚ An active calendar that is maintained daily
- ✚ A time log that shows all hours and dates I work
- ✚ A mileage log of miles put on our union car that I use
- ✚ A receipt log showing all receipts I submit
- ✚ A pay slip log showing how much I am being paid

The above is the basics that will be available on my website for members. It will be in the secured section of the site and members will have to register a login name, password and email address to get approved to view the secure section of the site.

These are promises that are well within my power to be able to maintain and keep.
